

2025 UTMyl Student Scholarships

The University of Tsukuba, Malaysia (UTMy) offers the following non-repayable scholarships for students. Only students who have completed the enrolment procedures can apply for these scholarships.

If you wish to apply, please carefully read the application guidelines sent with the enrolment documents and submit your application by the deadline. Please note that there are limited numbers of each scholarship. If there are many applicants, scholarship recipients will be selected after screening.

2. Application eligibility

Only students who have completed the enrolment procedures can apply for these scholarships.

3. Students who are ineligible to apply

- Students who are already receiving or will receive a scholarship or grant (including living assistance) from other scholarship bodies/foundations

- Students who plan to take a leave of absence during the scholarship period for which they plan to apply.

4. Scholarship Recipient's Qualifications

The UTMyl or the scholarship foundation / founder (hereafter refer to foundation) shall promptly disqualify scholarship recipients (hereafter refer to recipients) in any of the following situations:

- When the recipient loses his or her status as an enrolled student at the university.
- When the recipient is suspended or otherwise punished by his or her enrolled university.
- When the recipient repeats a year.
- When the recipient's academic performance or conduct becomes unacceptable.
- When the recipient has been absent for a long period of time without a valid reason.
- When the recipient does not attend an event related to the foundation without a valid reason.
- When the recipient does not meet obligations such as submitting annual academic report that the foundation ask him / her without a valid reason.
- When the UTMyl or the foundation otherwise determines that the recipient is not suitable to qualify as a recipient.
