



# 2025/2026 UTM<sub>y</sub> Student Scholarships

- The University of Tsukuba, Malaysia (UTMy) offers the following non-repayable scholarships for our students. Application for all scholarships begin in September 2025.

## Annual Scholarships & Assessment

### ASSESSMENT

- For first-year students, recipients will be decided based on admission results.
- Students from second year onwards will be decided based on their results in the previous academic year.

### TSUKUBA SCHOLARSHIP A

- Eligibility Criteria: Open to Malaysian and International students
- Scholarship Value: Equivalent to 500,000 yen (Around RM14,000)
- Number of recipients: A few from each grade
- Scholarship period: One year, paid once in October

### TSUKUBA SCHOLARSHIP B

- Eligibility Criteria: Open to Malaysian and International students
- Scholarship Value: Equivalent to 20,000 yen (Around RM600)
- Number of recipients: A few from each grade
- Scholarship period: One year, paid every month

### NITORI INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

- Eligibility Criteria: Open to Malaysian and International students
- Scholarship Value: RM9,500 (RM4,740 for each payment)
- Number of recipients: 10 from all grades
- Scholarship period: One year, paid twice
- Obligations: Submit report every semester and attends meetings with foundation representatives

# First-year Students' Scholarship & Assessment

## ASSESSMENT

- Recipients will be decided based on admission results.
- Students who are awarded this scholarship will not be eligible to apply for any other UTMMy scholarships for the duration of their studies.

## MABUCHI INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

- Eligibility Criteria: Open to Malaysian and International students
- Scholarship Value: RM999 per month and RM1,500 for entrance preparation
- Number of recipients: 2 First-year students
- Scholarship period: 4 years, paid every month
- Obligations: Submit report every semester and attends meetings with foundation representatives

# Second-year Students' Scholarship & Assessment

## ASSESSMENT

- Recipients will be decided based on their results during the first academic year.
- Only students who have enrolled and completed their first year in UTMMy are allowed to apply for the scholarship.

## KEIKO FUTURE SCHOLARSHIP

- Eligibility Criteria: Open to Malaysian students
- Scholarship Value: RM1,700 per month and at least one possible sponsored trip to Japan
- Number of recipients: 1 Second-year Malaysian student
- Scholarship period: 3 years, paid every month
- Obligations: Submit study reports and attend meetings with the scholarship's sponsor

## IMPORTANT NOTE:

- First-year students may only apply after enrolment.
- The deadline for scholarship applications is strictly imposed.
- UTMMy will not entertain the requests from students who wish to apply once the deadline has passed.
