Paying your tuition fees for Academic Year

Please ensure you have enough money for your day-to-day living expenses for the duration of your course. We would also expect you to pay your tuition fees for each academic year within the deadlines stipulated by UTMy, so remember to plan ahead.

- Approximately 40 % (5/12) of tuition fee at the start of Fall semester (September -January) and the balance of 60% (7/12) at the start of Spring semester (February -August) of the academic year (semester basis) or
- 100% of one academic year fee at the start of Fall semester of the academic year.

Usually, payment is due on 15th September for Fall semester and 25th February for Spring semester. If the dates fall on a weekend or a bank holiday, the due date is the next working day. (e.g. If 15th September falls on *Maulidur Rasul*, the due date would be 16th September.)

- **Note 1:** Please DO NOT pay your tuition fee for Fall semester BEFORE 1st September.
- **Note 2:** If you want to pay 100% of one academic year fee at the start of Fall semester, please contact the Academic Service Office before you proceed the transaction.
- **Note 3:** Failure to settle the tuition fees even after being demanded by the University will result in expulsion from the University.
- **Note 4:** If the amount is revised while enrolled in the University, the revised amount will be applied from the date of revision.

Payments can be made by:

Bank transfers (telegraphic transfers) or direct bank-in

Please note that telegraphic transfers take an average of two weeks processing time. You are advised to make your transfer through the bank and avoid making payment through a money changer. Please ensure that you give the correct details to the bank and indicate your Student ID number in the reference column.

- **Note 2:** We'll prepare another payment platform by the payment period for Spring semester. Once it's ready to use, the Academic Service Office will notify to all students.

Certificate of Receipt

The University will not issue a certificate of receipt unless students request it. Please contact the Academic Service Office for further details.

Refund of Tuition Fee

The University will not refund/exempt tuition fees where a student takes a leave of absence or withdrawals from the programme, except where <u>special circumstances</u> apply as below.

Leave of absence

If you need to take a temporary break for more than two months, you may request a Leave of Absence. Depending on the approval date and period of absence, the tuition fees for the approved period may be exempted.

Withdrawal

Withdrawing from the University means that you will no longer be recorded as a student of the University and will no longer be entitles to supervision or the use of University resources. There is no refund/exemption of tuition fees if a student is enroled for even one (1) day and withdraw in the middle of the semester.
